Dear Friends,

We move into this forty day period of Lent where we take time to understand something of the suffering of Christ and his path to the Cross culminating in the victory over death as he rose again defeating the powers of darkness and death. Lent has been observed since apostolic times as a period of reflection and repentance particularly for those who would be baptized on Easter. In the early history of the church, strict fasting was observed throughout this period. One meal was allowed per day, in the evening, and meat, fish, eggs, and butter were forbidden. Fasting during this period continues even now and people prefer to give up things like meat or chocolates or anything else that they are particularly fond of. While fasting may be a good thing we need to remember that it is not done to show others about how spiritual we are.

As we enter this period of Lent may it be a time of soul searching for each of us. We are all sinful human beings who have gone astray from God. God calls everyone to urgently repent. We are called to bear the fruit of the Spirit in our lives. If we fail to produce fruit in our lives in spite of God investing his Son in us then one day he will judge us.

Let us take time to be at the Lord's feet by reading his word and spending much time in prayer. Temptations will come when you fast and pray just as Jesus himself was tempted, but we are called to stand firm and rebuke the evil one with the word of God just as Jesus did. May we make every effort this Lenten Season to become more like Jesus in our thought, word and deed.
